S-3 PERIODIC REPORT

1. LOCATION OF TROOPS: No change.
2. WEATHER & VISIBILITY: Cloudy, limited visibility, light rains & cool.
3. OUR OPERATIONS:
 - a. Infantry:

1st Bn: Nil activity during the night. A "B" Co patrol to vicinity (16.1-10.95) had not returned at close of period. Nil activity for all other Bn patrols.

2d Bn: Nil activity during the night. "D" Co made local security patrols with nil activity. An "S" Co advance was delayed until 1100 because of poor visibility & air strikes. Upon completion of Arty barrage vicinity (15.7-11.4) the advance got underway & were still advancing at the close of the period with nil contact.

3d Bn: Nil activity during the night. Bn patrols to S & E of BCT Sector reported nil activity.
 - b. Artillery: Fired harrassing fire throughout the period, marked targets for air strikes, fired direct support mission for Inf advance. 460 rounds expended during the period.
 - c. Engineers: Continued improvement & maintenance of supply route.
4. RESULTS OF OPERATIONS: Continued extensive patrolling towards HILL 1055 & E of HILL 3355 with nil activity.
5. INTENDED OPERATIONS FOR 2 JUNE: Continue recco & patrolling of BCT held area. Continue assault on enemy strong points along main axis of approach to objective.
6. CASUALTIES: No change.
